Timely training based on the needs expressed by our membership - Our 2011 Spring Workshop was a **FIRST** in the Nation! The federal Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, also called the *President's Advisory Council*, piloted its new Educational Program focused on local governments and organizations explaining how the Section 106 Review process works. Over 100 local officials attended the workshop given at the Chester County Historical Society, part of our new partnership program. The Fall Lecture continues the theme with a Presentation by Preservation Pennsylvania, PENNDOT and PHMC on the new PA Project Path on-line system and more Section 106 and related review programs at the Brandywine Museum on October 8th.

The advantage of the experience and knowledge of CCHPN and its many constituents - CCHPN, often working behind the scenes, provides guidance, training and support through its Municipal Support Areas (MuSAs) and help municipalities link to others that have undergone similar situations and challenges. CCHPN works directly with the Chester County government, is a founding sponsor of the acclaimed *Town Tours and Village Walks*, and interacts with Statewide, Regional and local governments agencies and preservation groups.
